**Trainers:** An experienced trainer who has successfully competed at a level higher than that at which he/she is teaching must accompany every rider. Please email me for names of trainers if you do not have one.

**Footing:** Our footing has amazingly good going in all conditions, however, we reserve the right to cancel at any time prior or during an event should we deem the footing or conditions unsafe.

MINORS will not be permitted to ride without a QRF Release which is signed by a PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN!
