Quail Run Farm is happy to announce the return of Meghan Markham from New York! Meghan who is a “learner” Judge will be Judging a Ride A Test October 17, Rain Date Sunday, October 18.

**Closing Date October 10! Times will be sent out by Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, or ASAP as we fill.**

**As you have probably heard, we have postponed our scheduled Fall Horse Trials to Hallowe'en Weekend Sunday, November 1st with Cross Country Schooling on October 31st.**

Meghan worked with our boarders at Quail Run Farm until her husband Greg was recruited to work in NY. Meghan took my lovely 17 2H Oldenburg mare Natiki SG from Training level Dressage to second level in two years having only competed in four recognized USDF Shows. She qualified for Open Training Level Championships with a good score and at the same show, she received two qualifying scores at First Level coming first and second in her two classes. Meghan was about to debut at Second level when Niki went lame and Meghan moved to NY.

Meghan, currently a Dressage Trainer at Whispering Farms, in Prosper, TX, is a dressage trainer through and through. She has shown great success with her students and their equine partners over the past 25 years. She has a strong, proven track record of improving her rider's show scores, riding technique and rider/horse integration. She comes with a wealth of knowledge and know-how that has been passed down to her from some of the sports most revered domestic and international trainers, such as Christian Garweg, Janet Foy and Jennifer Schrader Williams, to name a few. Meghan has trained in Washington, Texas, New York, Germany, and the Netherlands.

As a USDF L judge in training and national and regional award recipient, she knows exactly what it feels like to be in your saddle. Meghan will help you professionally progress to the next level in your riding.

For those unfamiliar with Ride A Test format, the rider chooses her test and rides it before Meghan. While the test is being scored, Meghan will discuss the test and instruct the rider to improve upon her weaknesses. The rider will then have the opportunity, to RE RIDE the test and improve her score!

Tests will be scheduled every 30 minutes and the cost will be \$60 per lesson. Meghan will also be present with Becky Brown who is our Dressage Judge at our Sunday, November 1st Dressage phase of our Horse Trial. Come and see how you improve over the two weeks!!

We will start at 9 AM. Please select a time which best suits your schedule. I will do my absolute best to fit you in as closely as possible to your preferred time. I anticipate that slots will fill up fast. Please sign up ASAP. Your check will not be deposited until the weekend of the R.A.T. If activity is canceled, checks will be shredded! If you must Cancel Please give 24 hours- notice so that we may fill your slot for refund.
